






Organizational Structure

What Does a County Extension Agent Do?

Strengthens Agriculture & Agribusiness

Improves Natural Resource Conservation and Environmental Stewardship

- **Ensures a safe, nutritious food supply**
- Strengthens Texas families
- > Develops leadership & citizenship skills among youth and adults
- >Enhances economic security and financial responsibility among the people
- >Improves the quality of life in Texas families



Qualifications

>Master's Degree in field relevant to Extension (or willingness to obtain within 8 years)

- ≻GPA of 2.5 or higher
- >Driver's License & personal vehicle with insurance
- > Willingness to reside in county
- >Satisfactory criminal background check
- **Satisfactory completion of application process**
- >Other requirements based on specific positions sought



Competencies

> Technical competencies relevant to position sought > Organizational effectiveness > Personal effectiveness Oriented toward action **Communication** > Development of others **Community involvement**

What will Extension do for me? Salary

- >\$31,000 (Bachelor's Degree)
- >\$35,000 (Master's Degree)
- >Adjustments based on relevant previous experience
- >Automatic \$3,900 increase over 2 yrs
- **>**Degree incentives:
 - Masters \$4k Doctorate \$6K
- **Career Ladder (\$2,400, \$3,600, \$4,800)**
