### Significant Leadership & Personal Development accomplishments from county Events & Activities

Live Oak County had a good year, holding a successful 2 day County Camp where 95 youth and 8 volunteer leaders attended.

- **481** Livestock Projects (all species)
- 325 Participated in County Livestock Shows
- 67 Attended State-level Livestock Shows
- 60 Attended District-level Agriculture & Natural Resources educational or competitive events
- 67 Youth Trained through "Quality Counts" Program

#### Local Training Opportunities for Youth and Adults

- 3 Rabbit Clinics: held for Exhibitors to get county fair updates and learn about showmanship and care of rabbits
- 2 Swine, Lamb & Goat Clinics: held for Exhibitors to get county fair updates and learn to care for their animals.
- 6 hoof trimming opportunities for all Beef exhibitors
- 76 livestock judging practices held for 22 livestock judging individuals

#### Significant Agriculture & Natural Resource accomplishments from county Events & Activities

We had 2 individuals place in the top 20 at the San Antonio Stock Show at the Dairy Judging Contest. We also had 1 senior team in the Senior Division to place 1st at the Jackson County Contest, 1 team in the Intermediate Division place 1st in the Guadalupe Co. Contest and various youth place in the top 10 at numerous contests. Our youth's hard work pays off.

- 7 Attended State-level educational or competitive events

#### Local Training Opportunities for Youth and Adults

#### Significant Family & Consumer Science accomplishments from county Events & Activities

4-H has had an extremely busy year in Live Oak County, and we are planning on growing and implementing more 4-H & Youth programs. We had 15 Rosette winners in the foods division of the Live Oak County Fair that were sold in the auction for a total of \$57,200.00
