Highlights of FCH programs within Duval County as well as Multi-County

The biggest accomplishment for this year was recognizing all three campuses in San Diego ISD (Collins Parr Elementary, Bernard Jaime Junior High and San Diego High School) as Healthy Texas campuses for the school year 2019-2020.

Walk Across Texas: Agriculture Commodities Expo: January 23, 2020 – 686 participants:

- During the WAT: Agriculture Commodities Expo, student feedback was attained. Most students stated they learned different things. Examples provided were not knowing bovine was beef or that sunflowers produced so many seeds. The younger students were not aware that meat came from different animal and not the grocery store.
- Feedback was also taken from parents who attended the event. Most appreciated the students being exposed to agriculture and developing an interest in a new topic.
- The most powerful feedback was the student leaders for each station felt empowered and knowledgeable when providing the presentations on different agriculture commodities. Several stated they developed an interest in agriculture that they previously did not have.
