

## When should you do a soil test?

- Test 3-6 months <u>before</u> any new plantings or applications of fertilizer
- Test once a year to track changes in soil health

### How do you get a test for free?

- Pick up a sample bag and instructions at your county Extension or NRCS office
- Follow the instructions to collect a soil sample
- Return the soil sample and completed form to your county Extension or NRCS office
- Results will be sent by email for free
- Review the results with your Extension agent or NRCS conservationist
