2022 Private Water Well Screening

On October 12, 2022, Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service of Atascosa, Dimmit, Frio, McMullen, LaSalle, and Zavala Counties hosted a Multi-County Water Well Screening. This gives well owners an opportunity to test for fecal coliform bacteria, nitrate levels, high salinity, and hydrocarbons. We had a total of **43 water samples** and **11** for Dimmit County.



Wildlife Management Field Day

On October 28, 2022 Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service, Texas Parks & Wildlife and USDA hosted a field day for landowners to learn about brush, quail management, financial assistance and reading your landscape. There was a total of **68 landowners** in attendance with a few who obtained CEU'S toward their applicator's license.
